If you are looking for ways to help your child make and keep good relationships with you, their brothers and sisters, and their friends, using Restorative Practices at home can help you find ways to improve how people get along and make friendships stronger.

When we ask questions in a kind way, it helps us understand how others feel and think. It also helps people who are having a problem take charge of fixing it. Practicing these questions at school and at home will make our school community stronger and help us get along better.

Using feeling words is a great way to show how we feel and what we need. When we name our feelings, it helps us learn more words to talk about our emotions instead of acting them out. It also helps us see how our actions affect others.
