- It is the parent or legal guardian's responsibility to submit immunization records for all children and students attending licensed child care or school in Ontario.
- To upload your immunization records directly to the Middlesex-London Health Unit, please scan this code and follow the instructions.
- Please ensure the entire record is captured in your picture, including the child's full name and birthdate. You can upload a record that has more than one page.
- Records can also be mailed, faxed to 519-663-0416 or dropped off at the CitiPlaza office location in London. Please choose just one method to submit records

Virtual Urgent Care: a free Ontario Health service for you and your family

Did you know - Southwestern Ontario residents have access to free virtual urgent care?

If you have an Ontario Health Card, you can access **free** online urgent care appointments with a nurse practitioner. Both adult and children's **same-day and next day appointments** are available. Virtual urgent care might be appropriate for you or a family member if you have a medical issue that is **NOT life-threatening but requires urgent medical attention** and you're unable to access timely care through a primary care provider. Examples of appropriate medical issues can be found on the website.
